| SB462    | <p>Under current law, when more than 50 gallons of petroleum, natural gas, natural gas liquids, LPG, or synthetic gas are spilled or released, it is considered a hazardous substance emergency. This act changes the minimum threshold to 3,000 gallons.</p> <p>Under current law, if a political subdivision or volunteer fire protection district provides services in response to a hazardous substance emergency, the person who controls the hazardous substance is liable for reasonable and necessary costs incurred by the political subdivision or fire protection district. | HB 736   | This substitute requires a telecommunications carrier to provide, upon request, call location information concerning the user of the service, including a wireless telecommunications service, to a law enforcement official or agency in an emergency situation that involves danger of death or serious physical injury or to any person where disclosure of communications relating to an emergency is required without delay. There will be no cause of action in any court against the carrier or telecommunications service or its officers, employees, agents, or other specified persons for providing this information to a law enforcement official or agency. | 3/11/09-HCS Reported Do Pass by Consent (H)<br>3/11/09-Referred: Rules - Pursuant to Rule 25(32)(f) (H) |
